"Our perspective always focuses on trying to do something unexpected," says Orange County-based Yamamoto who set out to create a chic and sophisticated tone. Votive candles and vintage glassware mingle with a modern color palette and decorative touches such as hammered-copper orbs and wooden place cards. "We like to incorporate a residential style within our designs," explains Yamamoto of her aesthetic, as exemplified by her choice of place settings and glassware. "Bringing in elements that you would see in a home creates an inviting and interesting touch."
